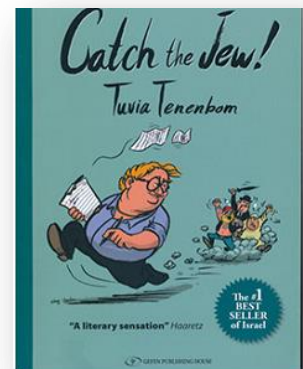

Rabbi Kaufman will be opening up a discussion on the topic of his dissertation, which is currently underway. Matthew seeks to triangulate the fields of the history of science, religion and print culture as a trajectory of inquiry into exploring the conditions of marginality, the limits of secularity, and the creation of self-understanding.

In a message from Rabbi Kaufman:

"I'm going to talk about my thesis, which is titled "Horace Kallen Confronts America". To the extent that Horace Kallen (1882-1974), a rather "minor" historical figure, is remembered at all, he is remembered as a man who helped to create American Zionism, and he created the concept of cultural pluralism.

His work is slotted into "ethnic studies" (of interest for sociologists looking at American history). I aim to go in a different direction. I look at Kallen as someone who is intimately connected to Modernism. I will introduce Kallen to everyone, and point to connections that I draw between him and the poet T.S. Eliot, George Gershwin's music "Rhapsody in Blue", and the Israeli artist Ya'acov Agam and his kinetic art. I'll explain how Kallen's notion of Jewish identity relates to modernism, and is based upon scientific ideas found in evolutionary biology and in quantum physics and relativity.

This is all new scholarship that has not been done before. I hope this sounds like it will be of interest."
