

Childrens Lives after The Holocaust



# Survivors



Despite volumes about the Holocaust, the research documented in "Survivors" published in 2020 uses archival material and interviews to tell an untold story—that of young children who lived through the way in concentration camps, in hiding or in a variety of homes or institutions, and of what happened to them after the war. Rebecca Clifford's ability as a historian meshes with her skill at making history accessible. Her talk will also describe how these children learned to say what they thought interviewers wanted to hear, to sometimes not acknowledge that they had a living parent, and to often shape their stories in ways that might increase their odds of survival.

Rebecca Clifford, our guest speaker, is a professor of modern European history at Swansea University in Wales. Originally from Kingston Ontario, her research on child survivors is not only scholarly but also personal. She'll share that as well at the event.
