From Rabbi William S Tepper and Educator Sue Potechin

April, 2021 - Date and Time TBA

Topic: Jerusalem of Gold.

Rabbi Tepper and Sue Potechin are collaborating on a one-hour learning program for Iyr HaMelech – via ZOOM, focusing on the song Yerushalayim Shel Zahav/Jerusalem of Gold.

Rabbi Tepper will take the first part of the program to share the backstory/events - in 1967 - leading up to the writing and first performance of the song.

Sue will then take us into a 'deep dive' of the song's meaning - the significance of the lyrics and music.

Israel's 'other' anthem: Yerushalayim Shel Zahav / Jerusalem of Gold by Naomi Shemer

Among other items, they will include for screensharing YouTube performances of the song - and a possible live one, too!

They will allow time for questions and conversation regarding the song's place in the Israeli/Jewish view of the world.

DATE / TIME: TBA

Their preference would be to hold the program around the time of Yom Ha'atzmaut (Saturday, April 17 or the afternoon of Sunday April 18). Perhaps a weeknight before or after.

Alternatively it could be around Yom Yerushalayim (Monday, May 10) or another evening that same week, such as the afternoon of Sunday May 2 or 16.
